Our nation is blessed with so many opportunities our lives are often frenzied as we try to take advantage of all the possibilities. As we celebrate our Independence this weekend, perhaps we need to be aware of our dependence on fashion, fad and cultural pressure to consume.

UPDATE

In May the Westhill School District taxpayers overwhelmingly passed a resolution to complete the purchase of St. Ann's for \$2,750,000. This has kicked off a number of actions within St. Charles-St. Ann as we look forward to a closing date sometime this Fall.

We are actively pursuing a nearby location to house the Faith Formation activities.

We have hired an architect as we begin the process of re-purposing the available space at St. Charles.

The emptying of St. Ann's has been underway. There's more to do and we're working to identify uses for the balance of the contents.

We continue to ask for clarity from the Diocese regarding use of the sale proceeds. While we are frustrated by the lack of answers, we do recognize that disposing of a property while the Diocese is navigating a bankruptcy settlement is a unique set of circumstances. We will continue seeking answers as we get closer to the closing.

We'll keep you informed as we navigate all of these circumstances. We are planning a Town Hall Meeting for the end of Summer/early Fall.

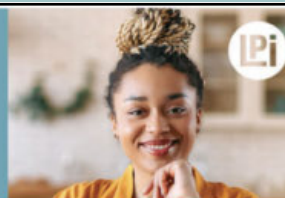

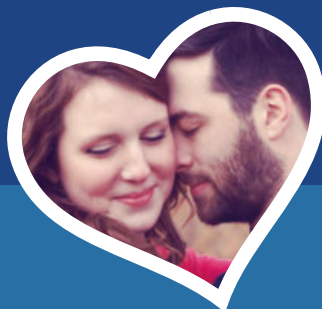
