We hope to start with an event during Advent if we can make this happen. In order to move forward there will be a meeting "of the minds" on Wednesday August 30th at 6 pm in St. Charles church to discuss possibilities and how to move forward. VIRTUS TRAINING

Just a reminder to all those who come into contact with children as part of their ministerial duties at St. Charles and St. Ann's that you must be certified through VIRTUS. Per the Diocese, "The basic curriculum is for all clergy, religious, employees and volunteers whose ministry or role places them in regular contact with children, young people or vulnerable adults as well as those parents and other adults who respond to our invitation to participate in safe environment training".

The major components of the diocesan policy are:

A diocesan Code of Conduct;

- Initial training on the prevention and detection of child sexual abuse within sixty (60) days of assumption of duties;
- Re-certification training every five (5) years to maintain a culture of awareness, knowledge, and vigilance for those entrusted in our care;
- Criminal background checks every five (5) years;

If you believe you fall into this category or if you lead a ministry of people who fall into this category and are not VIRTUS trained please contact Sr. Eileen McGrath at emcgrath128@gmail.com for information regarding when classes are available etc. Your certification is good for 5 years once you take the initial class and thereafter you can take a shorter recertification class. Thank you
