



RESPECT LIFE

The pro-life cause will confront new challenges in the coming decades, with physician assisted suicide in particular emerging as a growing threat to human life, Cardinal Sean P. O'Malley of Boston told attendees of the 25th annual Cardinal O'Connor Conference on Life on Jan. 20. The annual conference, organized by Georgetown University students, is held around the annual March for Life in Washington. It was first held in 2000 and later named in honor of the late NY Cardinal John J. O'Connor, founder of the Sisters or Life known for his pro-life activism, including his opposition to the death penalty and his support for social safety net programs.




