We begin the Lenten season on Wednesday. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and lasts for six weeks until Easter. It is a time when we observe a period of fasting, repentance and prayer. We need to set aside a time to reflect on the suffering and death that Jesus endured for us. During this six week time we should be strengthening our faith and develop a closer relationship with God.

**PLEASE NOTE**-in order to be considered a parishioner of St. Patrick's you must fill out a census form which are located in the vestibule or call the rectory and we will mail you one. If you need a form to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation we cannot give you one unless you have been registered in the parish for at least three months. Adult children who do not live at home have to fill out their own census. Any problems call the rectory.

**ENVELOPES** – if you are receiving envelopes and are not using them please call the rectory and have us remove you from the list. It costs us for postage and printing of the envelopes so please let us know if you no longer wish to receive them.
