

# Respect Life

207 members of Congress say Roe is 'unworkable'. Ahead of the Supreme Court's March 4 oral arguments in Gee v. June Medical Services, LLC, more than 200 members of Congress- 39 senators and 168 House members- signed an amicus brief in support of Louisiana's law that regulates surgical abortion clinics. The brief also claims that the 1973 Roe v. Wade decision and the ruling in Planned Parenthood v. Casey, which says states cannot put "undue burdens" on abortion access, are currently unworkable as states try to regulate the abortion industry. As we await the Supreme Court's decision on the Louisiana case, we applaud these lawmakers for standing up not only

for the lives of the unborn, but also for standing up to the abortion industry that continues to ignore the safety of women.
