

Blessings in a backpack is a program where food is sent home on Fridays with children who would otherwise be hungry. The food needs to be in small quantity form. **Lent in practice** – who must abstain from meat and when? Catholics ages 14 and older are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday (February 26th) and Good Friday (April 10th) as well as on all Fridays during Lent.

Lent in practice – who must fast and when? Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast (eat only one full meal; two smaller meals may be taken but may not be equal to the one full meal) on Ash Wednesday (February 26th) and Good Friday (April 10th). When possible, the fast from Good Friday should continue until the Easter Vigil. This is called the "Paschal Fast." It is done to enter into the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare more fully to celebrate his Resurrection.




