## Respect Life

Legislation has been introduced into NYS that would authorize assisted suicide by allowing doctors to legally prescribe a deadly dose of pills at the request of a patient with a terminal diagnosis. While proponents may call it "death with dignity" or "aid in dying" in reality these proposals would authorize the direct and intentional taking of human life.

Catholic teaching holds that assisted suicide is gravely immoral, both for the patient who is assisted and any persons who assist. It violates the sacred value of human lives, particularly those who are vulnerable to illness, age or disability.




