

#### Respect Life

In one of his first acts regarding abortion as president, Joe Biden rescinded the "Protect Life Rule," which banned taxpayer funds from being used to promote or provide abortion by family planning initiatives under the Title X Family Planning Program. Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann of Kansas City, Kansas, chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities; responded to Biden's action, writing, "By rescinding this rule, the administration will be forcing abortion into a pre-pregnancy program specifically designed to exclude abortion; a move which is immoral, impractical and may also be unlawful." 




