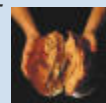

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on June 19 2020. The Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse, New York, ("Diocese") filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

The Bankruptcy Court has established April 15, 2021 at 11:59pm (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the "Bar Date").

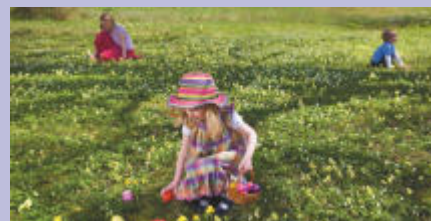

Respect Life

In one of his first acts regarding abortion as president, Joe Biden rescinded the "Protect Life Rule," which banned taxpayer funds from being used to promote or provide abortion by family planning initiatives under the Title X Family Planning Program. Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann of Kansas City, Kansas, chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities; responded to Biden's action, writing, "By rescinding this rule, the administration will be forcing abortion into a pre-pregnancy program specifically designed to exclude abortion; a move which is immoral, impractical and may also be unlawful." As stated by the Our Sunday Visitor Editorial Board, we urge President Biden to recognize and act upon the Church's teaching on the dignity of human life, starting at conception.

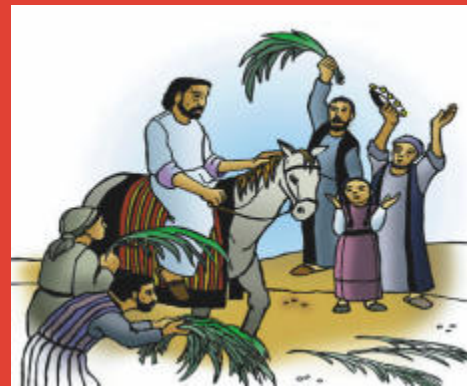
