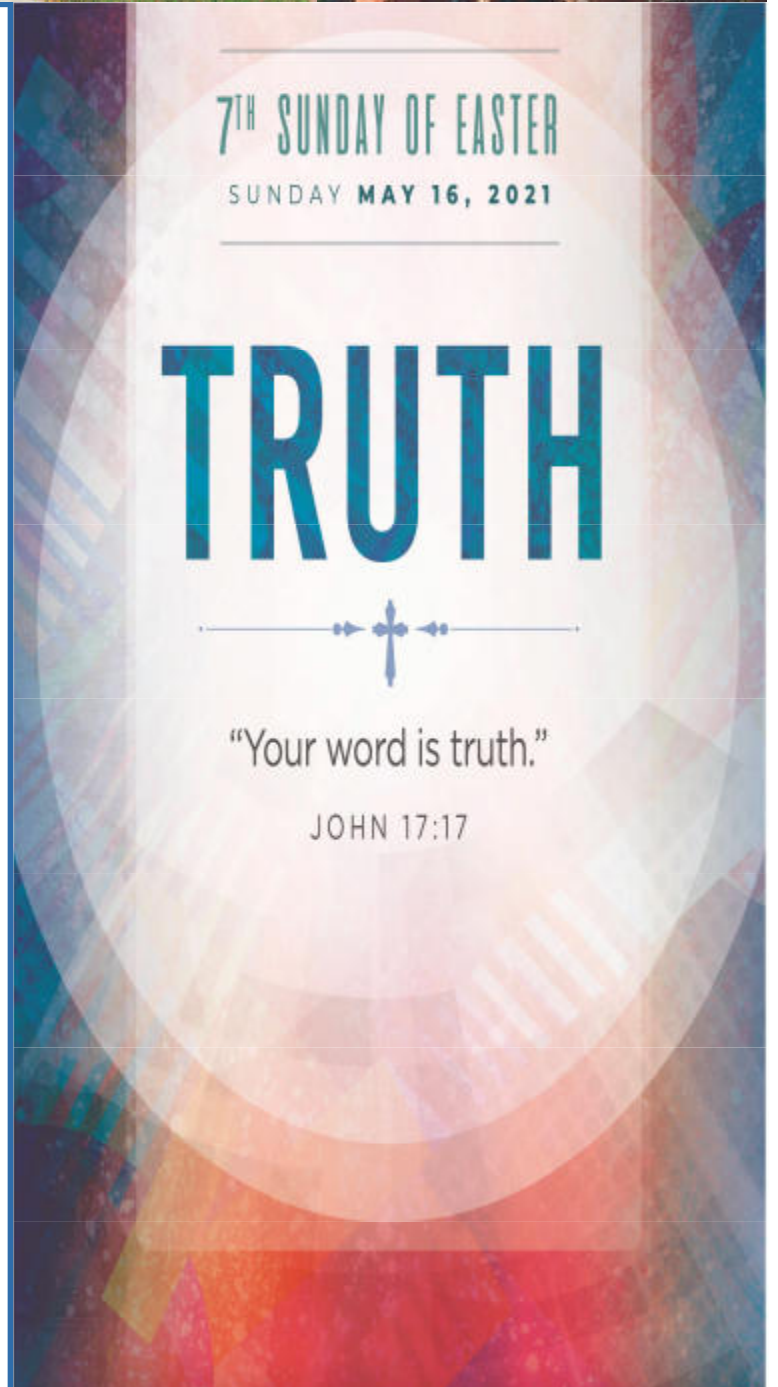

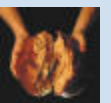

Rev. Msgr. Lawrence Bordonaro, CHH, JCD, a native of Syracuse, NY and the son of Antoinette DiPaolo Bordonaro and the late Carmen Bordonaro, Sr. of Westvale, NY, celebrates his 45th Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood. A graduate of Bishop Ludden

High School, he studied at St. Jerome's Seminary. He was ordained at St. Charles Borromeo Church, Westvale on May 28, 1976 by Bishop Frank Harrison. Monsignor is a priest of the Archdiocese of Toronto and serves as Judicial Vicar for the Toronto Regional Marriage Tribunal, an Interdiocesan Tribunal consisting of nine dioceses in Ontario, Canada. He also assists at St. Andre Bessette in Maple, Ontario. His early years of ministry were primarily in education and assisting in various parishes. In 1985 he was sent to study Canon Law at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome. He received his Licentiate in 1987 and his Doctorate in 1989 with his doctoral dissertation on Separate Schools in Ontario, Canada and their Canonical relationship to the Church according to the Code of 1983. Upon his return to Canada he served as Judicial Vicar for the Diocese of Hamilton; Associate Judicial Vicar for the Canadian Appel Court, and Associate Judicial Vicar for the Toronto Marriage Tribunal. In 2003 +Aloysius Cardinal Ambrozic appointed him to his present ministry as Judicial Vicar for the Toronto Regional Marriage Tribunal. On February 1, 2014 His Holiness Pope Francis appointed him to the Papal Household as Chaplain of His Holiness with the title Monsignor. On the day of his ordination Monsignor embraced the words of the Prophet, Micah 6:8, *Yahweh asks of you only this: to act justly, love tenderly, and walk humbly with God. In thanksgiving for the grace received in living out his call to priesthood in service to the People of God.*

Effective July 1, Monsignor will be retiring. Congratulations on your anniversary and retirement! Well done, good and faithful servant!

ATTENTION ST. CHARLES- ST. ANN ALTAR SERVERS

Both Father Kevin and I miss having you as part of our liturgy each weekend!! Know that you and your families have definitely been in our thoughts and prayers. During the month of August, I will start training new servers (those who have made First Eucharist and anyone older, too.), and Katie Boyea will put together a formal schedule that will, hopefully, start in **September 2021**. There may be a few minor changes in procedures due to the pandemic. We will definitely inform you of those changes before we **formally** start up again.

At the present time, any server who has been attending Mass or plans to be at Mass, and would like to serve may do so, provided that the following criteria are met:

1. Give me a call during the week or email me to let me know that you will be at Mass and would like to serve at either the 5:15 or 10:30 Mass (315-468-2283 or aparatore1@verizon.net).
2. Be at church at least five minutes before Mass.
3. We cannot have any more than three servers at one time, **so first call, first serve each week.**
4. At this time, servers will simply vest before Mass, process in with Cross and candles (single file), and one of you will ring the bells at the kneeler, and at the end of Mass, servers will process out (single file) with the Cross and candles. Of course masks must be worn and social distancing must be maintained. Even though what you do as servers has changed, know that your prayerful service is missed and appreciated and does make a difference in our liturgy!!!

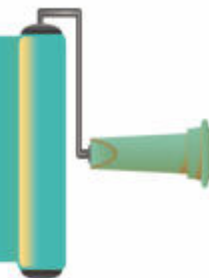
