

## Respect Life

Over the course of the past two months, it's been difficult to keep track of the myriad legal maneuverings regarding Texas' law that effectively bans all abortions after a fetal heartbeat can be detected. On Oct. 6, a federal judge blocked enforcement of the law, only to have that ruling be overturned two days later by a federal appeals court. On Oct. 18, the US Justice Dept. asked the Supreme Court to block the abortion ban. The Supreme Court responded by announcing Oct. 22 that it would grant an expedited review of the law and was set to hear oral arguments on Nov. 1. As we anticipate the court's ruling, let us remember that this issue is not simply a political football. Real lives are on the line and we continue to pray for an end to abortion.
