

## Respect Life

The new abortion law in Texas, which bans abortions after a heartbeat can be detected, has brought debate across the nation. But the Catholic bishops of Texas want to emphasize a long running state program called Alternatives to Abortion that assists pregnant women and families in need. The Texas Catholic Conference, the policy arm of the state's Catholic bishops, said, "Texas has invested hundreds of millions of dollars in programs for pregnant moms and families." The state has more than 200 pregnancy centers that provide diapers, formula, clothing, toys, books, car seats and furniture as well as pregnancy tests, adoption referrals and nutrition and counseling resources. While it might not get the headlines, such a program is vital to the care of mothers. All states would do well to follow Texas' lead.


