



Three kings followed the star- Caspar (King of India) brought frankincense which stood for Christ's divinity.

Melchior (King of Persia) came with gold-stressing Christ's kingship.

Balthasar (King of Arabia) lack skin, black beard— wears a purple cloak, brought myrrh— an embalming oil— a symbol of death.

\*\*Custom of blessing your house- using chalk or blessed chalk you would place above your front door on the inside the following inscription: 7N+C+M+R+77

The letters also represent Latin words CHRISTUS MANSIONEM BENBEDICAT WHICH MEANS "MAY CHRIST BLESS THIS DWELLING."

Choice of one of two prayers that goes with the blessing:

- 1. Lord, God of heaven and earth, you have revealed your only begotten son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who live here and all who visit. May we be blessed with health, kindness of heart, gentleness, and the keeping of your law. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our love for each other may go out to all. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
- 2. Almighty Father, incline your ear. Bless us, and all those who are gathered here, your angel send us, who will defend us, and fill with grace all who dwell in this place. Amen.

#### A Note From our Pastor regarding email solicitations:

There have been reports from parishioners across our diocese who have received emails and texts from individuals claiming to be their pastor. Usually the content of the message will include some form of request for money that is outside of the normal channels of giving, for example electronic gift cards for amazon or iTunes. These messages usually include some sense of urgency and may span over several emails, beginning with an inquiry like "Hi are you available? I have a quick request." Some of these fraudulent attempts have gone so far as to create email accounts which look very much like an official address. Please be aware that neither our parish nor father will ever reach out to you directly via email text or social media for direct solicitation of gift cards, wire transfers or other electronic monetary transactions. If you suspect you may have received a fraudulent request, or would like to confirm the genuineness of a message, please contact our parish office. 


