Study will investigate role of maternity homes in U.S.

The role of maternity homes has shifted from when they first began in the 1980s and 90s. Today, there is a rising correlation between crisis pregnancies and broken families, trafficking or substance and domestic abuse. "Now we are seeing that (reunited with family) is not the case, because now these women are totally alone, abused and trafficked," said Valerie Humes, a housing specialist for Heartbeat International and the National Maternity Housing Coalition. This spring, Heartbeat international is collaborating with the University of Notre Dame's Wilson Sheehan Lab for Economic Opportunities to study the impact and the evolving role of maternity homes, in the hopes of better serving women facing crisis pregnancies.

We applaud these efforts determining how to best serve these vulnerable women and their children.

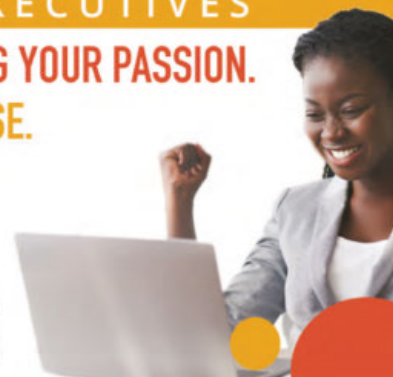
