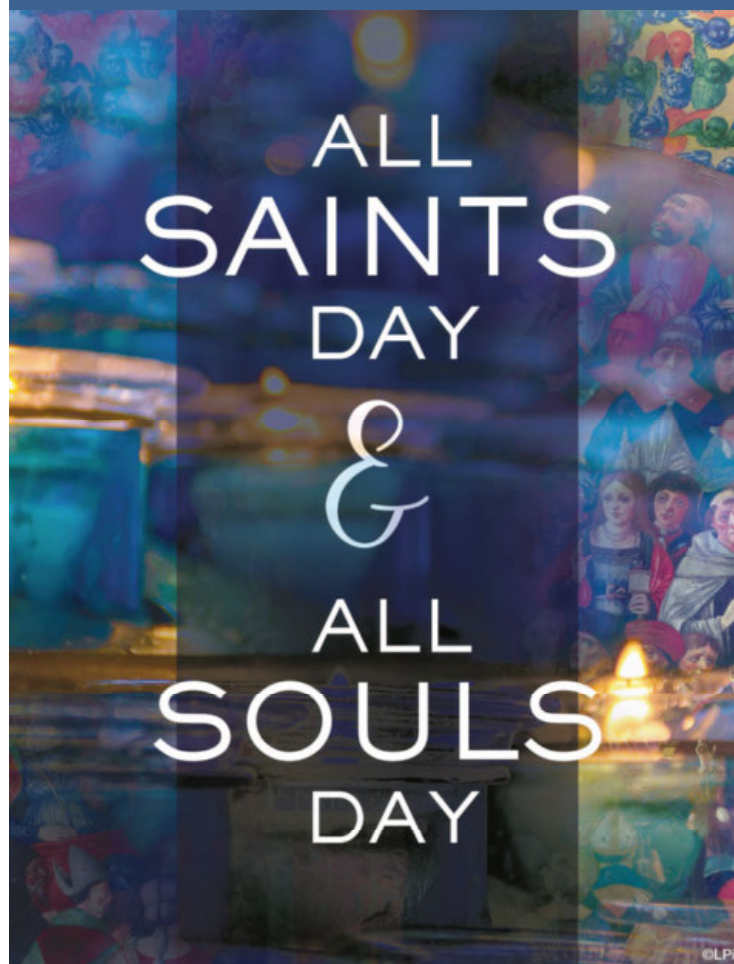

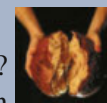

### St. Patrick and St. Brigid HOPE Appeal Assessment

2022 HOPE Appeal. Our assessment is 35,669.15. This is an increase of 976.10 over last year. As you know our assessment is based on our parish regular income. It seems like everything has been increasing from groceries to gas, just to name a few common items. Unfortunately that is the same for the many services that are offered through the HOPE Appeal. This year the HOPE Appeal requirement is back to normal. We will be expected as a parish to pay our full assessment. The full amount of our assessment is due by December 31, 2022. That gives us only 16 weeks. If each family gave a donation to HOPE Appeal of \$70, which is roughly \$4.38 per week we would definitely meet our goal. This is the same equivalent to a cup of coffee from Dunkin or Starbucks, and less than a pint of Guinness from a local establishment, just to put it into perspective.

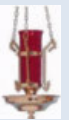

Respect Life      To Live Each Day with Dignity:

To live in a manner worthy of our human dignity, and to spend our final days on this earth in peace and comfort, surrounded by loved ones—that is the hope of each of us. In particular, Christian hope sees these final days as a time to prepare for our eternal destiny. Today, however, many people fear the dying process. They are afraid of being kept alive past life's natural limits by burdensome medical technology. They fear experiencing intolerable pain and suffering, losing control over bodily functions, or lingering with severe dementia. They worry about being abandoned or becoming a burden on others. Our society can be judged by how we respond to these fears. A caring community devotes more attention, not less, to members facing the most vulnerable times in their lives. When people are tempted to see their own lives as diminished in value or meaning, they most need the love and assistance of others to assure them of their inherent worth. The healing art of medicine is an important part of this assistance. Even when a cure is not possible, medicine plays a critical role in providing "palliative care"—alleviating pain and other symptoms and meeting basic needs. Such care should combine medical skill with attention to the emotional as well as spiritual needs of those facing the end of life.

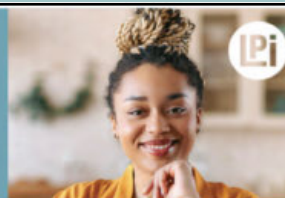
