Rehearsal for that day will be Thursday, May 11th from 6:30-7:30pm at St. Patrick and St Brigid.



The American Association of Pro-Life Obstetricians and Gynecologists has attended the annual conference of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) on medical education for the past 15 years. But this year, conference organizers revoked the prolife doctors' booth space without prior notice.

"Despite multiple requests for an explanation as to why, the only explanation that we received is a vague explanation that we disagree with ACOG, presumably on the issue of abortion." she said.
