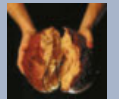

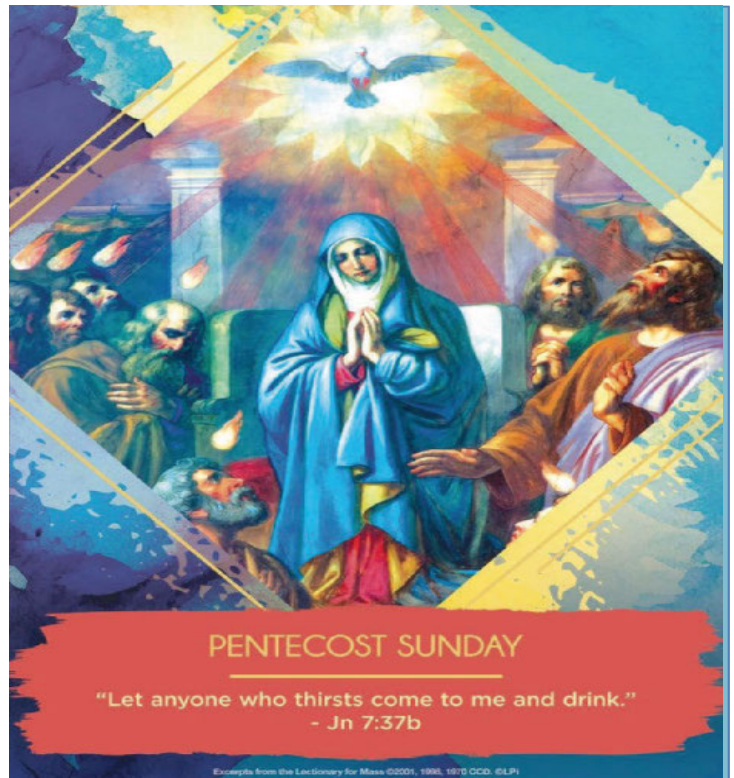

Bishop Rhoades: Notre Dame Lecture

Bishop Kevin C. Rhoades of the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend, Indiana, said that a lecture series on "reproductive justice" at the University of Notre Dame is advancing "activist propaganda" rather than conducting a neutral inquiry or exploring the debates within this field. In his column for Today's Catholic, the newspaper of the diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend, Bishop Rhoades spoke out strongly about the university's study program's ongoing series titled "Reproductive Justice: Scholarship for Solidarity and Social Change." which featured speaker Ash Williams, who, according to the event's website, "has been vigorously fighting to expand abortion access by funding abortions and training other people to become abortion doulas."

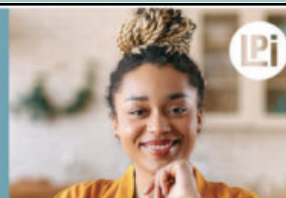

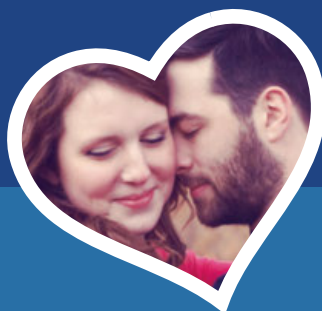
