"Instead of being just a church that welcomes and receives by keeping the doors open, let us try also to be a church that finds new roads, that is able to step outside itself and go to those who do not attend Mass, to those who have quit or are indifferent." — Pope Francis

Many of us think of the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA/now OCIA) as a way to bring non-Catholics into the fullness of our faith. That's true...to a point. If you have not had a chance to see the article printed in last Sunday's newspaper shining a light on the homelessness crisis in Syracuse, it is mind-boggling to think that we have more than 1,000 children without homes, living in motels, unable to cook a meal unless it can be warmed up in a microwave. There just is not affordable housing for many families.

Family homelessness has exploded this year in Onondaga County. The numbers are triple what they were at this time last year, and 5X what they were before COVID-19 and growing.

More than half of the families seen at the Salvation Army shelter have never been homeless before. Many of them are working. But still cannot find a real home. When you don't know where your next meal will come from, or where your family will sleep at night, something has to give, and often it is school that takes a back seat and that is where many children are able to eat. The food pantry has been working with school social workers since last fall to help with necessities for families living in motels, including microwaveable foods and snacks. But more help is needed. If you can add a few items to your grocery cart it would be very helpful. The full article is on Syracuse.com titled, "**the school buses run to motels: Syracuse's homeless family crisis.**"
