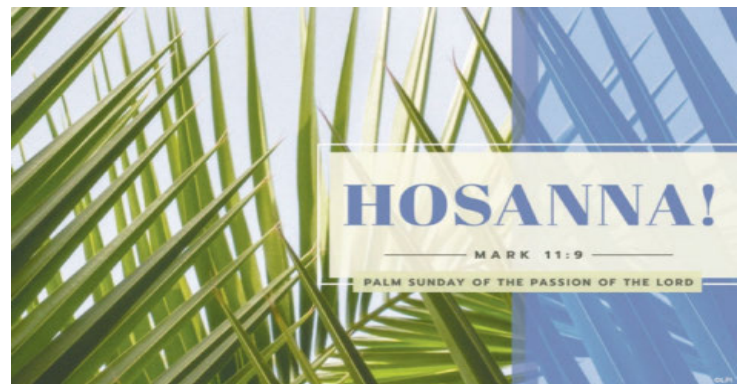

Milk Mission

April 1st begins our 11th year of the Milk Mission. The Milk Mission supplies much needed gallons of milk to those in need in our inner city. Each week we purchase 70 gallons of milk: 40 gallons goes to Assumption Food Pantry and 30 gallons goes to St. Lucy's Food Pantry. Eleven years ago, milk cost \$1.89 per gallon and all we ask from parishioners and friends is to donate \$10 a month or \$120 for the year.

Milk has gone up to \$3.09 and we have not asked for more than \$10 a month. We have 57 people who donated last year and many gave above and beyond the \$120 for the year. We did not raise enough money to purchase all the milk. The sad realization is that Assumption Food Pantry now gets 80 families in one day – the 40 gallons of milk only last about a day.

We need 40 more individuals in order to continue purchasing this much needed milk. You can contribute one check for the year or pay us monthly. We are so grateful to the people who have donated all these years, but the need is greater than ever. I have never seen so many lined up at the window at Assumption each week as I have seen this year. Please if you can join in, consider helping in this much needed mission. I promise that all money collected goes directly to purchasing milk. If you think about it, you can't even buy a good pizza for \$10 a month.

St. Charles-St. Ann's has always been so generous in all the many ways we reach out to help those in need. Letters will be mailed out to those who have contributed over these many years.
