This account, which is a restricted account, will continue to be used for all capital improvement projects for our parish property. Please feel free to continue making donations to the account, as you know maintaining our property is ongoing. We are very fortunate here at St. Patrick and St. Brigid's to have so many very generous parishioners.

Trustees Financial Update

We wanted to provide a financial update of activities that have occurred over the past 6 months.

As you are well aware, all parishes are required to make a contribution towards the settlement of the Diocese Chapter 11 case. The amount of the contribution is 55.1% of the 06/30/2023 balance in what is known as the parish's unrestricted funds. The amount due to the Victims' Trust Fund for St. Charles – St Ann's is \$496,786 and is due by 06/01/2024. In anticipation of this, in early 2024 we set aside funds from our investment account into a short term CD. The proceeds from the CD and some additional cash from our savings account will allow us to make this payment.

On 11/07/23 we closed on the sale of the St. Ann's church and buildings for \$2,750,000. After closing expenses and real estate brokerage fees, we also set aside \$100,000 for expenses related to planning for a remodel of St. Charles. The balance of \$2,582,000 was deposited by the Diocese into a trust account for St. Charles-St. Ann's Church. We do not know at this point when we'll be able to access these funds.

We have recently paid the Diocese \$10,827 for our 2023 Hope Appeal arrears.

While none of the above items are considered "good" news, we're struck by the good fortune that finds us able to pay the settlement from our long term investments while setting aside the windfall from St. Anns. We indeed are benefiting from those who came before us.

Respect Life

When Jessica Hanna was diagnosed with cancer while pregnant, she fought to find treatment that would preserve the life of her unborn child. Months later, she had a healthy baby boy and showed no signs of cancer. But tragically, her cancer soon returned. Throughout her illness, she shared her story with her nearly 50,000 followers on social media using the powerful handle @blessed_by_cancer. She died April 6, leaving behind a legacy of pro-life advocacy and an example of a steadfast trust in God, no matter what. On her Instagram page, Hanna frequently shared that she was grateful for the physical healing, but more grateful for the spiritual transformation God had begun in her. "We have to stop thinking earthly. We have to always focus on eternity," she wrote. "Yes, I am blessed by cancer, by suffering, by my cross."
