




Hope Appeal

St. Charles- St. Ann's parish has been assessed at \$45,895.00. This is a decrease of \$16,105.00 We are fortunate that our assessment has decreased this year. It may be the only expense that has decreased this year. It seems like everything has been increasing lately from groceries to gas, just to name a few common items. Unfortunately, that is the same for the many services that are offered through the Hope Appeal. We will be expected as a parish to pay our full assessment. The full amount of our assessment is due by December 31, 2024. That gives us only 9 weeks. So far we have received donations of \$21,407.00 leaving us with a balance of \$24,488.00.
