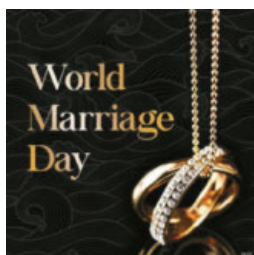

Our next meeting will be February 25th. It will be at 6:30pm at the Westhill High School Library. (Park in the front of the school and walk to the left to the library.)

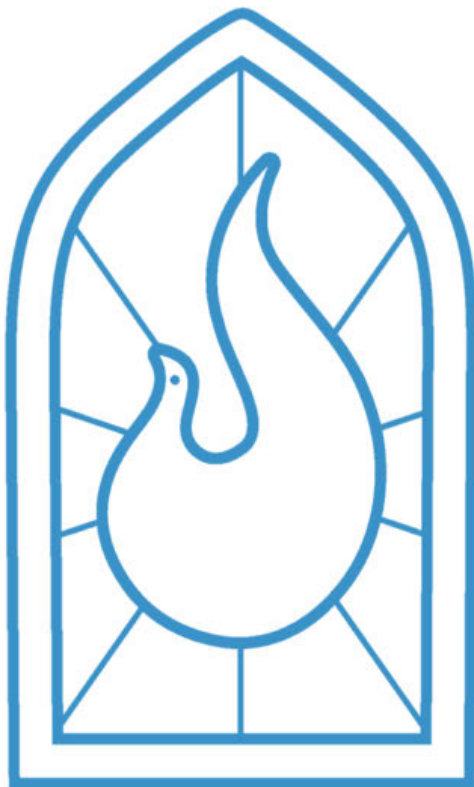
We will be writing cards for people at nearby senior housing communities at the next meeting. We would also appreciate large reusable shopping bags for people at the Rescue Mission.

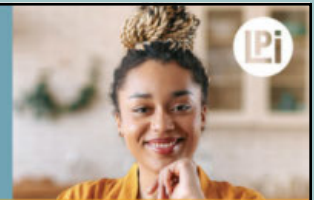

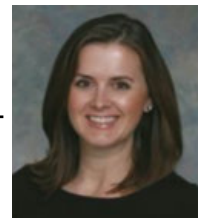
