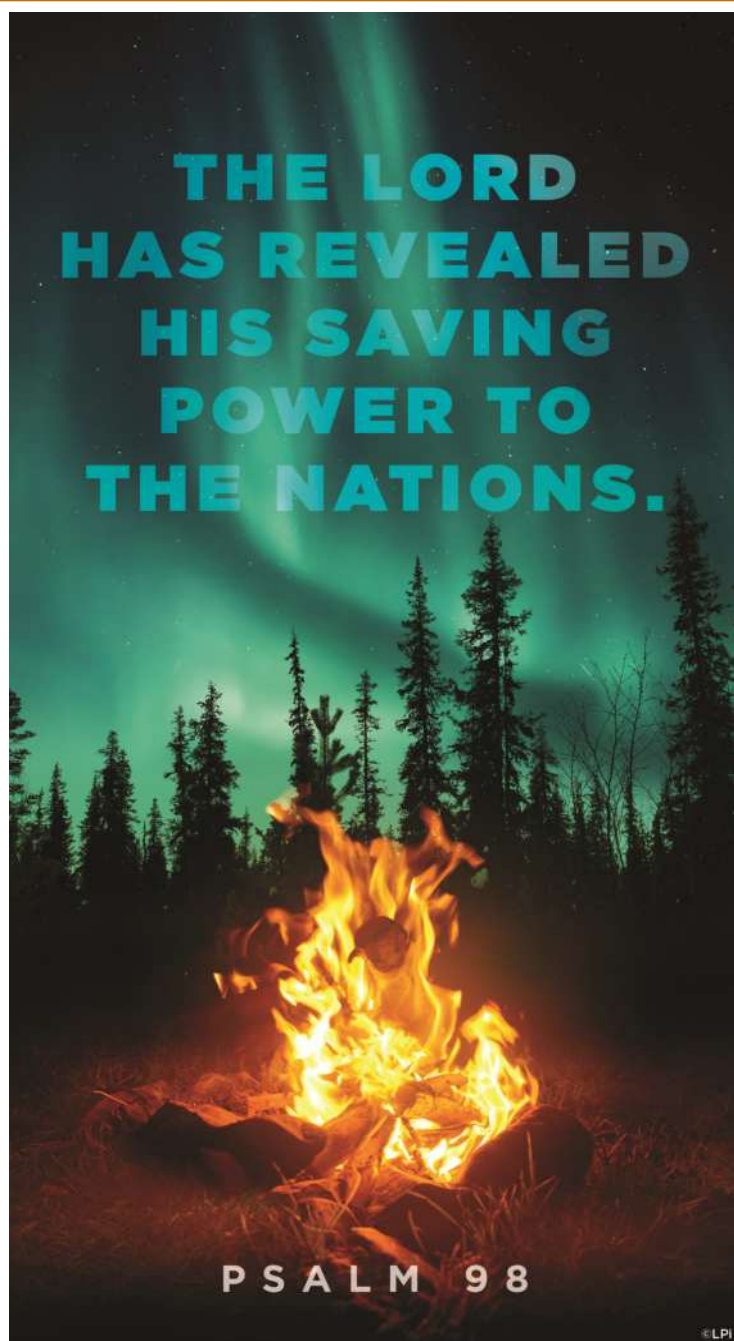

Hope Appeal 2025

*This weekend starts the beginning of the Hope Appeal. St. Patrick's and St. Brigid's parish has been assessed at **\$35,699.00**. We are fortunate that our assessment has not increased this year. It may be the only expense that has not gone up this year. It seems like everything has been increasing from groceries to gas, and utilities just to name a few common items. Unfortunately, that is the same for the many services that are offered through the Hope Appeal. This year the Hope Appeal requirement is back to normal. We will be expected as a parish to pay our full assessment. The full amount of our assessment is due by December 31, 2025. That gives us only 11 weeks. If each family gave a donation to Hope Appeal of \$70.00 which is roughly \$5.00 per week, we would definitely meet our goal. This is the same equivalent of a cup of coffee from Dunkin or Starbucks, and a pint of Guinness from a local establishment is around \$6.00. Just to put it into perspective. Thank you for all your continued support and generosity.*

To date we have raised \$7,757.00– 21.73 of our goal.

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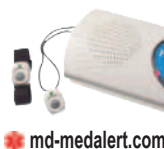
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
