Lent begins Feb. 18 this year. During this holy and penitential season, fasting is required of adult Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 by consuming one full meal and two smaller meals. The required days of fasting are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Abstinence, which is refraining from the consumption of meat, is obliged for Catholics 14 and older. Catholics are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent, including Good Friday.

Some exceptions apply in particular circumstances. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops indicates the following exceptions on its website: "Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting."

A mission of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse since 1946, the Brady Faith Center is located on the city's Southwest side, where we continue Monsignor Charles Brady's legacy of serving our neighbors in one of the nation's highest childhood poverty areas. Through more than 20 ministries, we build relationships by meeting people where they are — not as "us" and "them," but as one community in Christ.

Our ministries include Sunday Mass and Faith Formation; Feet on the Street, walking our neighborhood to share and receive God's love; the Brady Children's Choir; Pedal to Possibility, a community bike ride held three times a week where participants earn a bicycle after ten rides; four weeks of Vacation Bible

School; Summer Servants, a weeklong overnight service immersion experience for high school youth; and care for creation through our 5.8-acre urban farm and two community gardens.


