

Brady Faith Center

A mission of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse since 1946, the Brady Faith Center is located on the city’s South-west side, where we continue Monsignor Charles Brady’s legacy of serving our neighbors in one of the nation’s highest childhood poverty areas.

Through more than 20 ministries, we build relationships by meeting people where they are — not as “us” and “them,” but as one community in Christ.

Our ministries include Sunday Mass and Faith For- mation; Feet on the Street, walking our neighborhood to share and receive God’s love; the Brady Children’s Choir; Pedal to Possibility, a community bike ride

held three times a week where participants earn a bicycle after ten rides; four weeks of Vacation Bible

School; Summer Servants, a weeklong overnight service immersion experience for high school youth; and care for creation through our 5.8-acre urban farm and two commu- nity gardens.

We are grateful for this new partnership and look forward to advancing the Reign of God together.




St. Charles-St. Ann Food Pantry


