Milk Mission

April 1st begins our 13th year of the Milk Mission. The Milk Mission supplies much needed gallons of milk to those in need in our inner city. Thanks to our generous parishioners and friends, each week we purchase 100 gallons of milk to be shared by Assumption Pantry and St. Lucy's Pantry.

Thank God for all who have donated and thankful to Wegman's that the milk has been on sale these last months. The sad realization is that Assumption Food Pantry now gets up to 180 families in one day –the 70 gallons of milk doesn't last long and only goes to families with children. The need at all the pantries is overwhelming and both Churches are so grateful for this Milk Mission. For the past 12 years we have asked for only \$10 a month. I used to say it was the cost of one pizza, but finding a pizza for \$10 now is almost impossible. One mother asked Brother Cristofer if he had milk and when he said yes, she began to cry. It's hard to put ourselves in their shoes, but by your generosity we are making a difference. You can donate monthly, quarterly or one donation for the year. I promise that all money collected goes directly to purchasing milk.

St. Charles-St. Ann's has always been so generous in all the many ways we reach out to help those in need. Letters have been mailed out to those who have contributed over these many years. 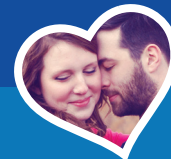
