

BAPTISM: Usually scheduled for Sunday during or after Mass. Parents should first contact the pastor for an appointment and also plan on attending one session of our Baptismal Preparation Program, which explains the significance of the sacrament and each part of the Baptismal rite. Many parents may find it more convenient to attend this session during pregnancy rather than after the birth of their child. We rejoice with joy in your happiness!

MARRIAGE: Congratulations! We want to do everything we can to make this day special for you. Couples should be members of the parish and make an appointment with the pastor at least six months before the desired date of the wedding. Participation in some form of Pre -Cana conference is necessary.

HOSPITAL: Please notify us if you or a member of your family enters the hospital so that they will be able to receive the healing Sacraments of Anointing of the Sick and the Eucharist.

HOMEBOUND: There may be times when you may not be able to get to Mass because of illness or the weather. If this is the case, please let us know so that we will be able to bring you Communion. Also, if you know of anyone who is permanently homebound, please let us know so that we will be able to schedule frequent Communion visitations.

THE LIGHTS OF CHRISTMAS

One of the most obvious signs of Christmas are lighted candles, window lights, luminaries, lights on the Advent wreath and Christmas tree all signifying that Jesus Christ is the Light of the World.

The Christmas Candle is usually placed in the center of the Advent wreath to complete the removal of darkness and sin by the coming of Christ.

Window Lights placed inside window sills depict a beacon to light the way for Mary and Joseph and the coming of the Christ Child.

Christmas Tree – to most people the tree is only a seasonal decoration – to Christians it symbolizes hope the light of Christ at spiritual darkness.

St. Boniface used the evergreen as a symbol of the eternity of our Lord.
